Confidentiality: Respect the confidentiality of information regarding the animals in our care, including their medical history, behavioural issues, and placement status. Respect the confidentiality of the foster carers or other volunteers within the rescue when transporting to and from their homes and with their personal information.

Representing the Organisation: As a representative of HAR it's expected of you to uphold our values and mission at all times. Be mindful of your actions and interactions, as they reflect on the organisation as a whole
